


Rebuilding Ukraine Association Incorporated (RUAI), is a




A Memorandum of Understanding outlining the **REUNITE** education initiative was produced by several of its participants and signed in Warsaw Poland on February 15th, 2023.





- 3. Ensure the utilization of leading-edge technologies and materials in re-establishing an independent, resilient, and sustainable Ukraine.






Human Capital Development Project

 - Develop sustainable and resilient solutions in the design, construction, and planning industries.


PHASE 1: "Start Now and Ramp up Gradually"

Phased Action Plan Focused on EU Integration

PHASE 1

Months 1-18: "Start Now and Ramp up Gradually"

- Strategic Planning Session
- Visiting Scholars' program (Strengthen Institutional Capacity)
- Awareness activities on university partner campuses
- Implement readily available technologies
- Recruit private sector stakeholders
- Formalize credentialing programs
- Rapid deployment of best practices for accelerated reconstruction of critical infrastructure projects
- Provide training on development of grant proposals

PHASE 3

Months 18-40: Sustained Rebuilding Efforts

- Address the planning, design, and construction of a Sustainable Ukraine
 - Feasibility, master planning and prioritizing of healthcare, education, housing and critical infrastructure (energy and transportation) projects
 - Recommend the re-establishment of primary businesses
- Coordinate with Ukrainian public sector start of construction








